Here are the particulars:

FTP access
FTP server: <ftp.frii.com>
Main Username: berthoudmain
Password: 45ccra25

SSH access
SSH server: <shell.frii.com>
Main Username: berthoudmain
Password: 45ccra25

For the shell access, you'll need an SSH telnet session. If you do not have one already, you can try downloading PUTTY (www.putty.nl/). For FTP, I like using LeechFTP (www.download.com/3000-2356-10122208.html?tag=lst-0-1 or <http://stud.fh-heilbronn.de/~jdebis/leechftp>) but most window's based FTP utilities work fine (I believe, but I haven't tried others).

Our web site root is </u/vp/berthoudmainstreet.org/www>. When you log into the FTP or SHELL servers, you're already at /u for the berthoudmain user.

Hope this helps. There is no need to archive anything on the server right now as I already have a backup copy. However, you may want to check with Deirdre before blowing it completely away <g>.

Hey there,

I did one more re-arrangement of the photos per Deirdre and posted the newest version on the demo site. Let me know what you think - if it's not working for you, we can keep tweaking it. I'm sure I can fit that cute watermelon girl in there, too :)

The design is for 600 X 800 standard resolution, which is what all new PCs are set at and most users never change. That does leave some white space at full screen on a higher res, but I find that allows users at high res (1024x768 or higher) room to do things like display their Favorites lists on the side, or view the site in less than a full screen window without losing the content display.
