#### INVESTIGATION:

On 10/08/2010 at approximately 1000hrs Chief Johnson referred a case to me involving a possible computer crime that occurred on 08/11/2010 against the Berthoud Mainstreet's web site that was reported to him by John Bauer.

Chief Johnson said John e-mailed him a statement that he would forward to me indicating that someone had deleted the Berthoud Mainstreet website at [www.Berthoudmainstreet.org](http://www.Berthoudmainstreet.org) and John believed it to be Jen Rotar that deleted the site.

I received John's statement from Chief Johnson. In the statement John said he checked the web site statistics on 08/25/2010 and noticed a "Page not Found" statistic. When John checked the website he discovered that it was gone. John called "Go Daddy", which is the host of the website, and was able to recover the FTP (File Transfer Protocol) logs that indicated someone from IP (Internet Protocol) address 174.29.150.58 had accessed the FTP files on 08/11/2010 at 1442hrs and deleted all of the data files associated with the website. John stated he was able to determine through the Internet that the IP address belonged to Qwest. John further stated that he called Qwest and the person he spoke with at Qwest told him the IP address was assigned to Jen Rotar on 08/11/2010 at 1442hrs. John stated that he filed a complaint at [abuse@qwest.net](mailto:abuse@qwest.net) and a police report.

I spoke with John on 10/21/2010 and John stated that the website was deleted shortly after the Berthoud Mainstreet board decided to go with a different web developer and the decision was published in the Berthoud Surveyor. I asked John to email the FTP logs to me and copies of any pertinent e-mails from Jen Rotar. John stated that he would and I received those e-mails later the same day.

I contacted Jen Rotar and informed her of the issue with the web site. Jen stated that she was the webmaster for the Berthoud Mainstreet website, had designed the site and was providing the service voluntarily. Jen said she had no idea the site was down and that no one had called her to ask about the site. Jen stated that Eric Boyd with Berthoud Mainstreet contacted her via e-mail in January asking if she could update the site. Jen said she emailed Eric back and said she could but would have to charge her hourly rate of \$45.00 an hour. Jen said Eric replied that he would let the Board know and would advise her of their decision. Jen stated that was the last she heard from the Berthoud Mainstreet program about the web site. I asked Jen if she could contact Qwest and see what her IP address was on 08/11/2010 at 1442hrs and she stated that she would.

On 10/22/2010 Jen sent me an email stating that she had contacted Qwest and they told her she did not ever have that IP address. Jen also stated that Qwest did not show that her account information had been accessed at all during August except for August 28th when she called due to Internet connection problems.

I called Qwest on 10/22/2010 and asked if they could tell me who the IP address belonged to on 08/11/2010 at 1442hrs and they would only confirm that the IP address was one allocated to them but would not provide any subscriber information, not even the state the IP address originated from.

On 10/29/2010 I obtained a Court Order for Production of Records for subscriber information for IP address 174.29.150.58. I faxed the Court Order to Qwest's Security Response Center on 10/29/2010 at 1708hrs. I received a response via email at 1148hrs on 11/01/2010 indicating that the IP address was assigned to Jen Rotar on 08/11/2010 at 1442hrs.

On 11/03/2010 at approximately 1600hrs I contacted Deputy District Attorney Mike Pearson and screened the case with him over the phone. DDA Pearson stated that he did not believe there was sufficient evidence in this case to meet the requirement of Probable Cause to charge Jen Rotar with computer crime.

I volunteer the following information of my own free will, for whatever purpose it may server: (Begin with date, time, and location of incident):

On the afternoon of Wednesday, August 25, 2010, I logged onto the hosting server where the Berthoud Main Street Program web site is loaded. I did this to capture statistics on the pages that have been frequented most, as this was being requested of our new web designer.

As I was capturing the statistics, I noticed a new set of statistics that I hadn't seen before. These statistics referred to how requests returned a "page not found" to the end user. This alarmed me as I didn't recall any of our links being broken. I proceeded to open a Internet browser window and entered the URL of our web site: <http://www.berthoudmainstreet.org>. I was alarmed to receive a "Page Not Found" as a result.

I immediately used the hosting features of our hosting company, GoDaddy, to see what happened to our front page. Much to my alarm, all the files for our web site were gone. I proceeded to contact GoDaddy support and speak with a technician. He walked me through finding when the last time our files were there. The backup for 08/10/2010 showed the files there, but there were gone by the time the backup of the site ran on the evening of 08/11/2010.

I inquired how this would have happened. He informed me that the logs did not show anyone logging into the hosting site directly using our account, but apparently someone logged into the server directly using the File Transfer Protocol (FTP) utility and accessing the server directly using separate login ID and password. I inquired which account and password and I was informed that this was a separate ID and password that was set up when the site was set up. As we had Jennifer Rotar from Rialiable Buisnesss Services volunteer to set this web site and hosting service on behalf of the Berthoud Main Street program, I was not aware of this separate account.

I asked how to restore the files back and the GoDaddy support analyst showed me how to restore all of our files. I did so with the analyst on the phone and then tested to make sure the site was back up. I then asked the support analyst to see I could get information or a log of when someone logged into the system and what they did while on there. He stated that he had entered a request from the server team to run an FTP log for August to show the activity on my site. Once the log was generated, I would receive an email with instructions on how to download the log.

On Thursday, August 26, I received an email from Go-Daddy informing me that the log was now available (see email attached). I downloaded the log and it showed that on 08/11/2010 at approximately 14:42:41, someone logged into the server using the "berthoudmain" FTP account from IP address 174.29.150.58 and deleted all of the files for the Berthoud Main Street Program web site. I did a reverse IP lookup on 174.29.150.58 and found that this IP address was issued to a Qwest customer during the timeframe of 08/10/2010 and 08/12/2010..

✱ I using the information from the reverse lookup results, I contacted Qwest customer support. Speaking to technician on the phone, he confirmed that the IP address was issued to Qwest DSL customer Dan and Jennifer Rotar from Berthoud, Colorado. The technician also informed me to follow up with an email to [abuse@qwest.net](mailto:abuse@qwest.net) as well as to file a police report on the incident.

I thanked the technician and followed up with sending an email to [abuse@qwest.net](mailto:abuse@qwest.net) and filing a report with the Berthoud police department.

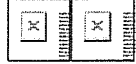

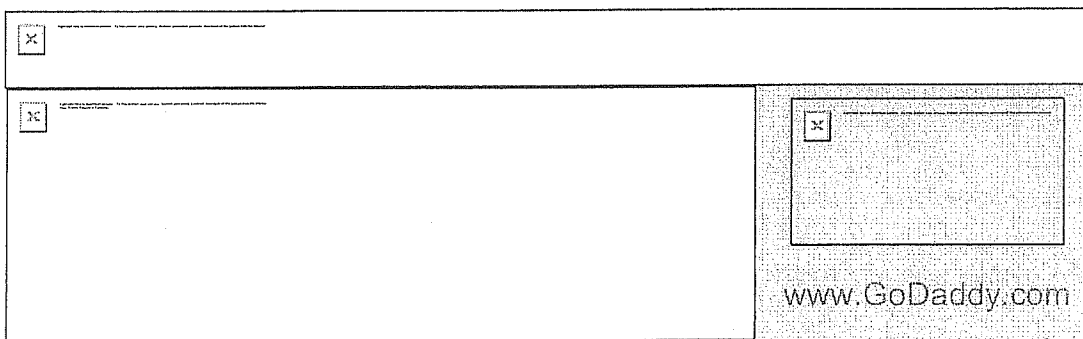

Good morning Officer Yachik,

Per our discussion yesterday, I made 2 phone calls to Qwest – one last night & one this morning in regards to my account.

Last night I spoke with Beatrice in the normal internet tech support dept.  
She gave me the current IP address for my account as 184-96-95-199.  
She did not have any record of the IP number you gave me in my account information.  
Nor was there any reference to anyone accessing my account in the last three months except for a call I made when our internet was down on August 28<sup>th</sup>.  
I asked if there was any way I could give her an IP number and find out if it was associated with me – NO  
I asked if there was any way a person could look up my personal Qwest account information based on IP on the web – NO  
I asked if there was any other number to call or any other department that handled IP info – NO  
In order to get my own current IP address, I had to provide my name, phone number, billing address and last 4 digits of my SSN.

I called again this morning and spoke with Doug (operator #DXTHO20) in the “advanced guru tech support dept”.  
I had to provide my name, phone number, billing address and last 4 digits of my SSN.  
He said that he could see a list of IPs that had been associated with my account, but that they do not include date ranges.  
He said there was no IP on the list that matched the number you gave me yesterday.  
He also said that no one had accessed my account to view personal data other than last night (Beatrice) and when I called in on August 28<sup>th</sup>.  
He said that if any operator signed in to view my personal information, their operator data would be captured and that they would be required to enter a note in the account about the purpose of the call.

There is no record of Mr. Bauer accessing my Qwest data unless he did it in some roundabout way and violated the privacy of my personal account.

I do not know why Mr. Bauer is convinced that I did some harm to the Berthoud Main Street web site and I am extremely upset and distressed about this matter. I have worked on the site since 2005 as a volunteer and have communicated directly with both John Bauer and Eric Boyd during that time. I have copies of all my email messages from various members of the Main Street board requesting work on the site, up until January of this year when I told Eric that I would no longer be able to volunteer but would be available for professional hire. I will forward you a copy of that email correspondence. Throughout the existence of the site, I have had a very cordial relationship with all the members of the board I had direct contact with, and I have absolutely no animosity towards the Main Street program.

I value both my business and personal reputations very highly. All my business is based on referral and I have always had good relationships with my clients. I volunteer a tremendous amount of time in the community in web development and serving on various committees. I would never do anything to tarnish my own business reputation or track record as a volunteer.

As far as I can tell, the BerthoudMainStreet.org site is exactly as I left it when I last updated it in 2007. If the web site truly had technical issues in August, Mr. Bauer should have called me directly and I could have looked at the account

then and determined the exact nature of the problem and helped him. It is absolutely ridiculous to me that he contacted the police department about this. I believe that Mr. Bauer has a personal issue towards me due to my involvement in Citizens First – an organization that demands transparency and accountability from our public officials - and that he is simply seeking to discredit me in public.

Once you have completed your report, I would like to receive a copy. I'm sorry that your valuable time has been taken up with this matter. Mike Hart and Mayor Patterson have both been informed of this issue.

## COURT ORDER FOR PRODUCTION OF RECORDS

To: Qwest Corporation

The court, upon review of an affidavit filed by Jeremy Yachik, a peace officer in support of the issuance of this order, hereby orders the production of the following records, for which there is probable cause to believe are in your actual or constructive possession or control:

Subscriber information for IP Address 174.29.150.58 on August 11<sup>th</sup> 2010 at 1445hrs (2:45pm).

The court also hereby finds probable cause to believe that the requested material constitutes records:

Which are or have been used as a means of committing a criminal offense;

Which would be material evidence in a subsequent criminal prosecution in this state, another state, or federal court;

and that such grounds and probable cause support the issuance of this order pursuant to §16-3-301.1.C.R.S.

Pursuant to §16-3-301.1, C.R.S., the above-named business entity shall produce the above-described records within 30 days after the date this court order is served. The records shall be delivered to the Colorado criminal investigator or peace officer named in this order during normal business hours. The records shall be supplied in any form or format that is convenient for the business entity and that may be accessed by the named officer or the officer's agency or department. The business entity shall also provide a notarized statement that the records produced represent complete and accurate copies of all records identified in this order that are in the actual or constructive control of the business entity. If the business entity does not produce all records identified in this order, it shall identify the records not produced. Failure to comply with this order shall support a finding of contempt of court.

Pursuant to §16-3-301.1, C.R.S., the peace officer named below is hereby authorized to serve this order during normal business hours of the above-named business entity, and to receive the records during normal business hours of the business entity. Service shall issue in the same manner as a summons under C.R.C.P.4 or by personal service on a manager or supervisor of the business entity. This order must be served within 10 days after the date it is issued. Upon receiving the records from the business entity, the criminal investigator or officer shall file a return and inventory with the court indicating the records that have been received, the total number of pages if supplied on paper, and the date upon which the records were received. The investigator or officer shall also file the original of the attestation of authenticity and completeness with the court.


